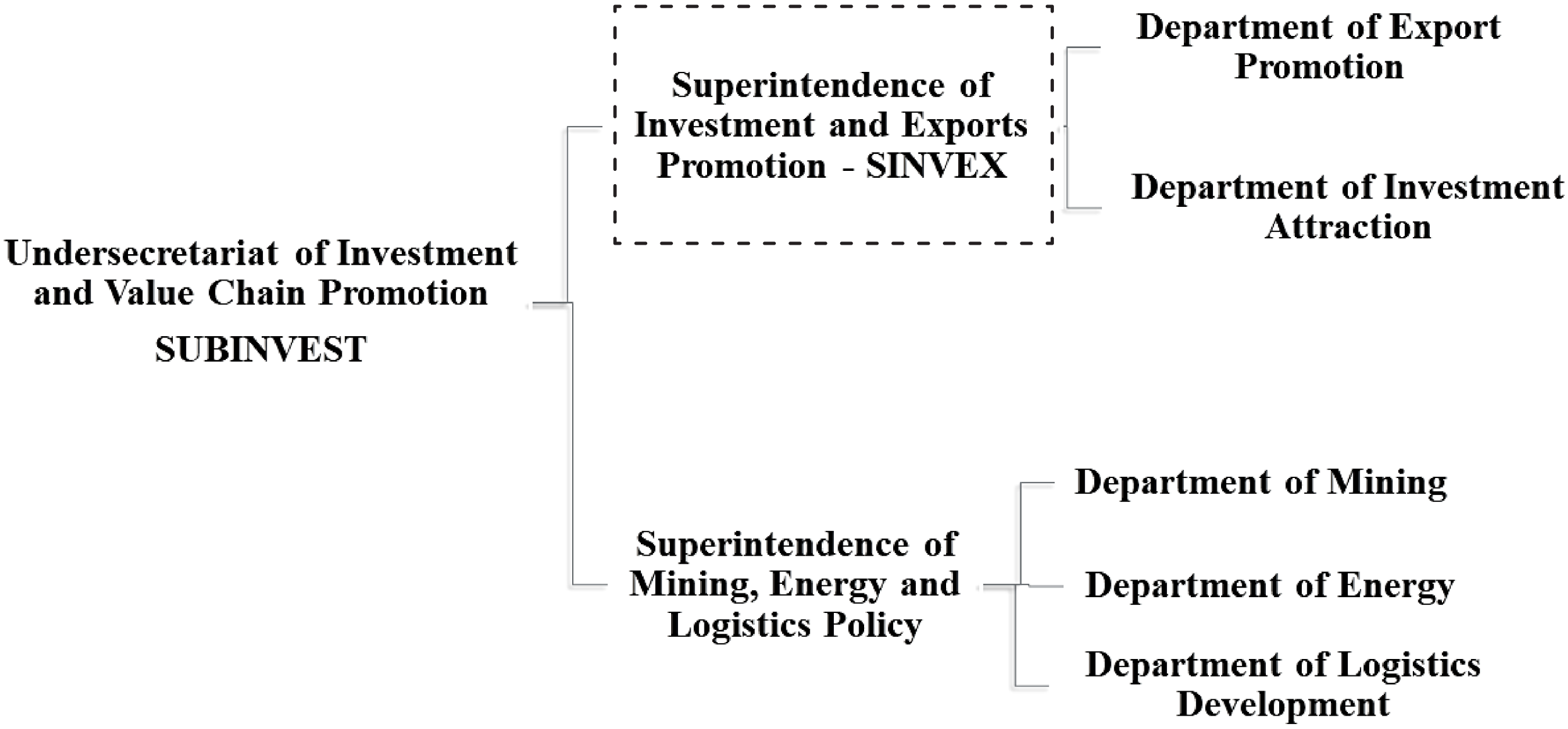

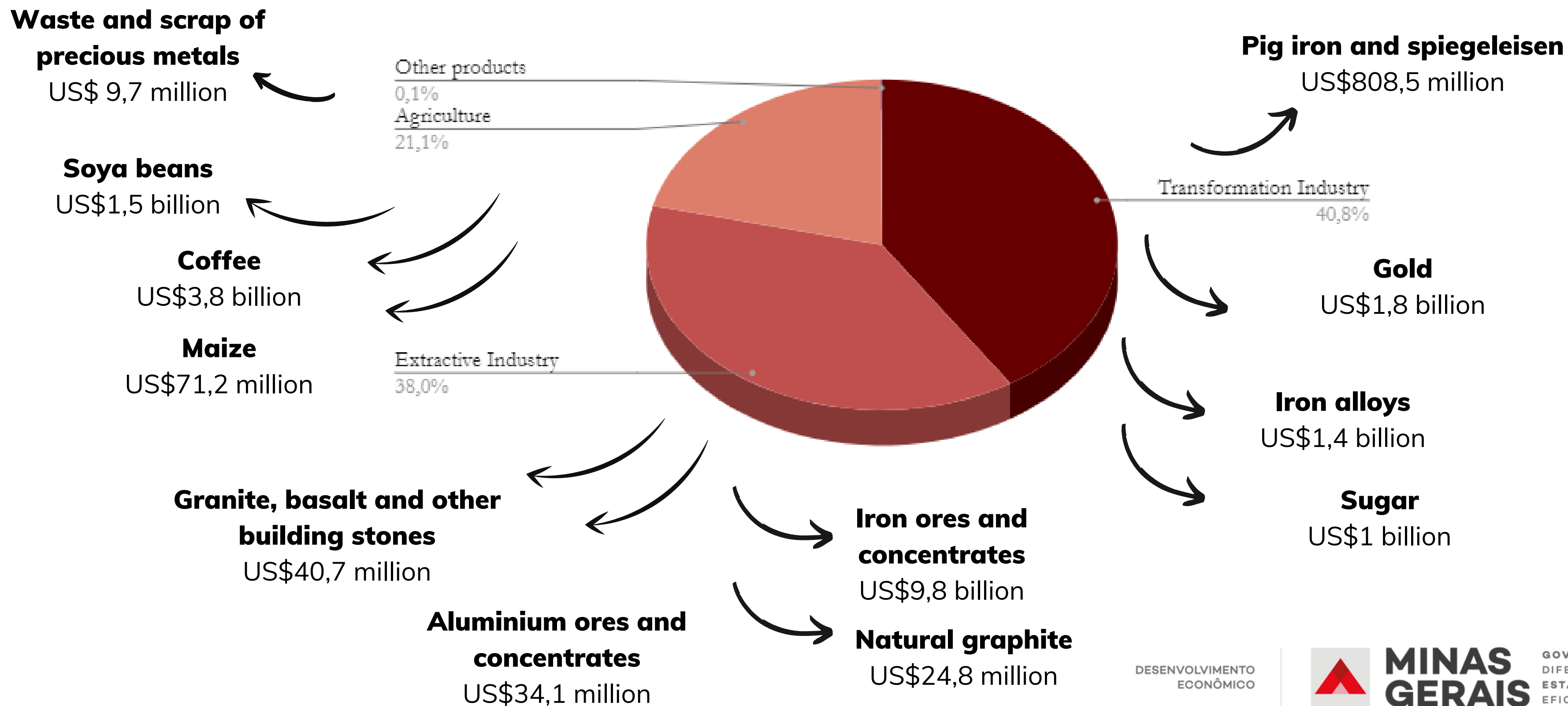

Minas Gerais exports: Main Products (2020)



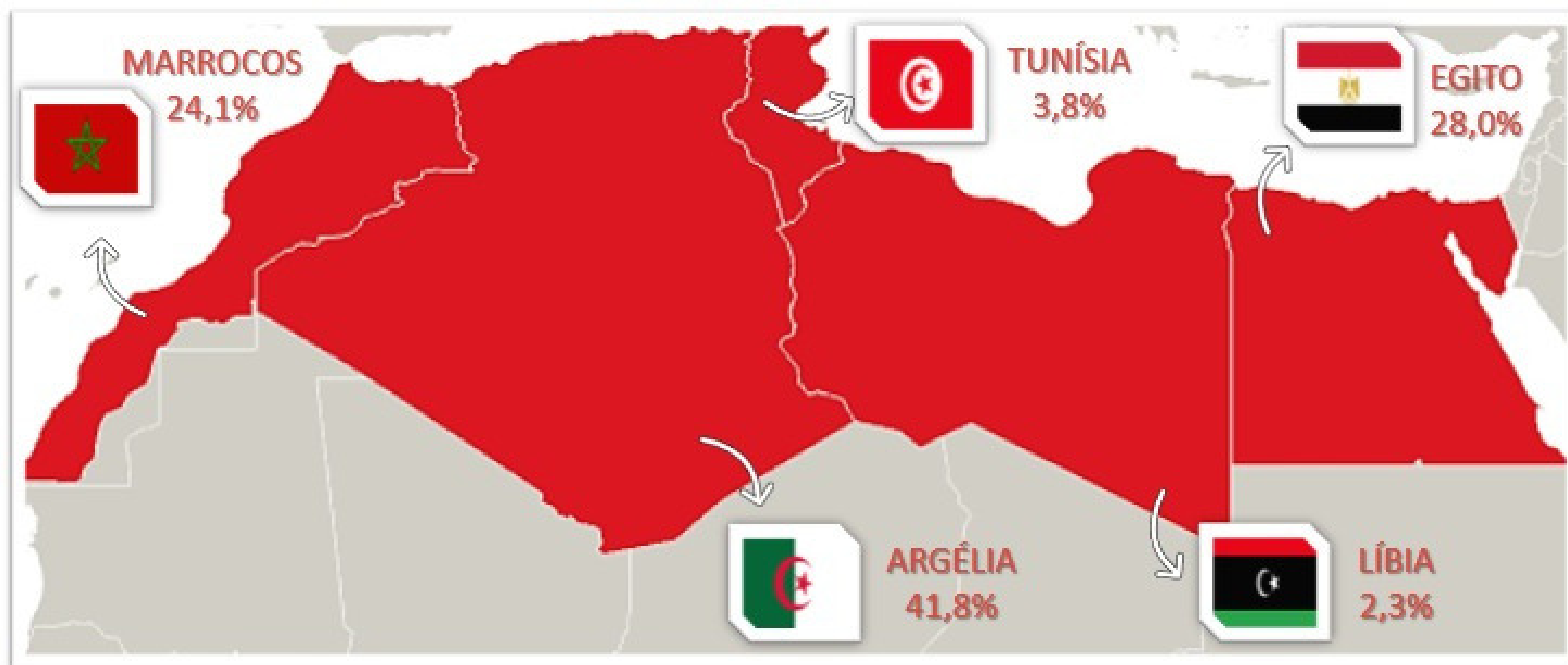
International Trade between Brazil and Egypt

- Trade between Brazil and Egypt reached US\$ 1.9 billion in 2020.
- US \$ 1.7 billion Brazil's exports to Egypt
- US \$ 212.1 million Brazil's imports from Egypt.
- 4.2% drop in Brazilian exports to Egypt in 2020, compared to 2019.

- In 2020, Minas Gerais was responsible for 5.4% of a total of US \$ 1.7 billion traded between Brazil and Egypt.
- Minas Gerais ranked 5th among the Brazilian states that exported to Egypt in 2020.

Minas Gerais' trade partners in North Africa



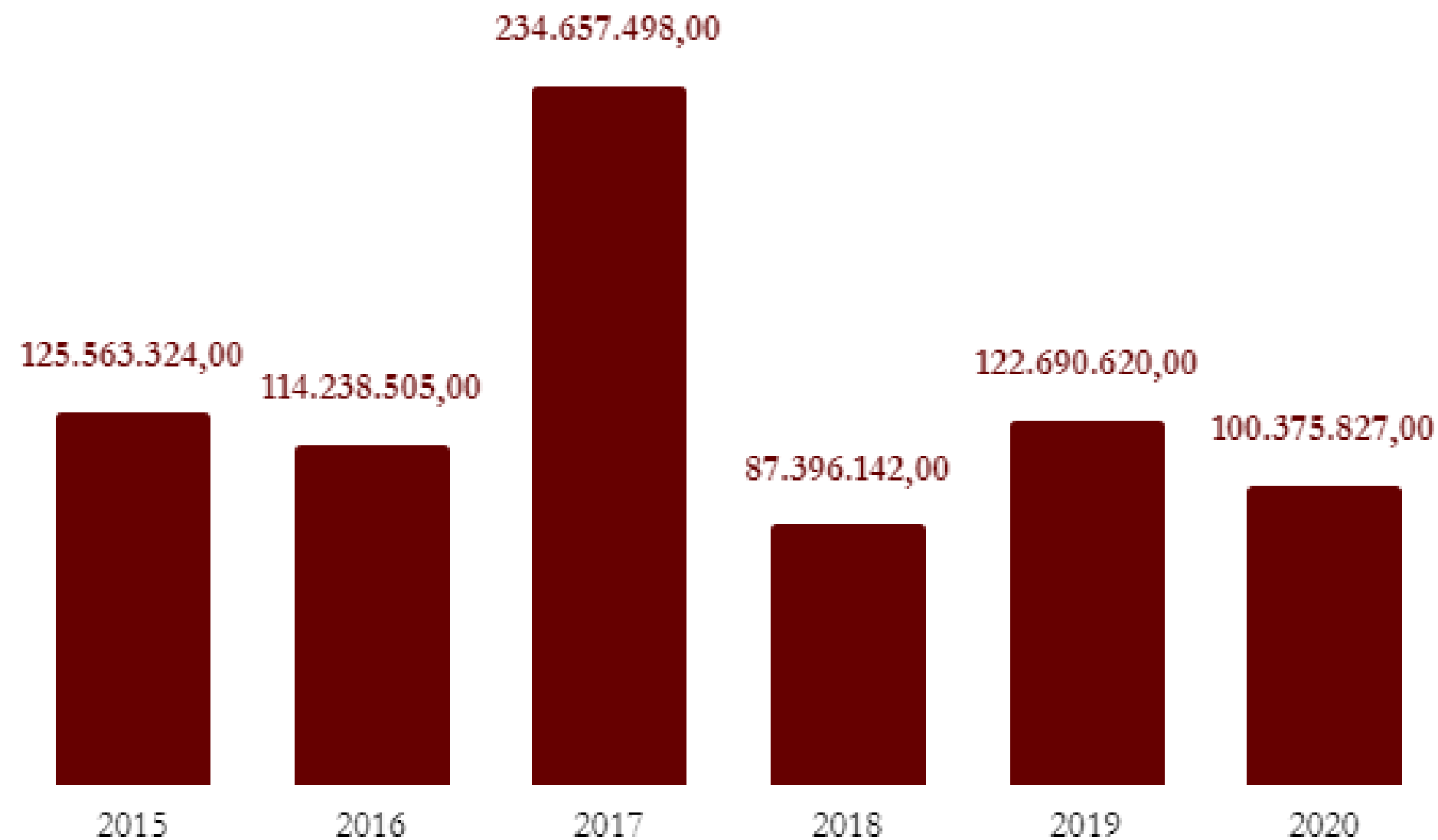
In 2020, exports from Minas Gerais to North Africa reached US \$ 336.7 million, of which 28% related to Egypt.

Egypt ranks 2th among north african countries in the Minas Gerais's exports and 3th in the imports.

Egypt was responsible for 6.4%. of Minas Gerais' imports from north african countries

EXPORTS FROM MINAS GERAIS TO EGYPT (2015-2020)

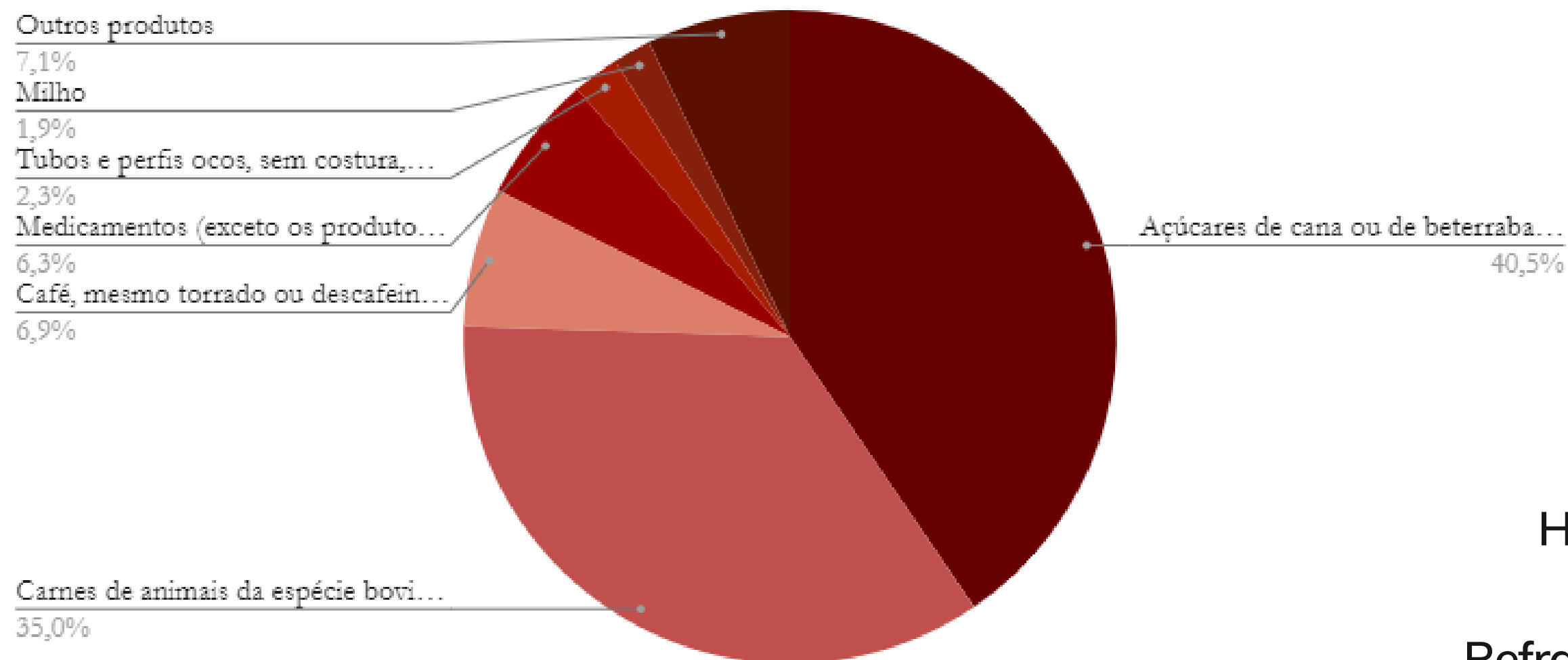


Exports from Minas Gerais to Egypt experienced a 10.9% drop from 2019 to 2020.

In 2017, the most exported product of Minas Gerais to Egypt was sugar.

Commercial ties between Minas Gerais and Egypt

Minas Gerais' exports to Egypt 2020 (US\$)



The main products exported in 2020 to egypt were:

- Sugar
- Meat of bovine animals, frozen
- Coffee
- Medicaments
- Tubes, pipes and hollow profiles
- Maize
- Aluminium ores and concentrates
- Hydrogen, rare gases and other non-metals
- Edible offal
- Refractory bricks, blocks, tiles and similar refractory
